

# Travel By Rail



Burton upon Trent railway station is approximately 4km (2.5 miles) from Drakelow Park. The Arriva 2/2A/2E bus service stops adjacent to the station, the journey takes around 20 minutes.

Travelling to the station on foot takes around 45 minutes and by cycle it takes around 12 minutes. Sustrans Route 63 takes you into the town centre (see enclosed cycling map). There is safe and secure storage for bikes, which is covered and monitored by CCTV.

Burton upon Trent station is served by CrossCountry services operating between Birmingham, Derby and Nottingham. Direct services (with no need to change trains) to a large number of destinations can be boarded at Burton upon Trent. See below for typical journey times to key destinations.
